TRIP#1 MAY 14-21, 2025

GUATEMALA SANTA CRUZ DEL QUICHE



COST OF THE TRIP: \$2,100

*Includes airfare, in country transportation, food and lodging

- → \$1,000 deposit due by March 2
- → \$1,100 due by April 25

DESTINATION: Santa Cruz del Quiche, Guatemala FLIGHT: Kansas City \rightarrow Atlanta \rightarrow Guatemala City.

→ From there we will drive to Santa Cruz. (roughly 4 hours) In Santa Cruz, we will stay at the mission guesthouse, which is about 10 minutes from the Children's Home. We will have morning breakfast and devotions together as a team at the guest house.

MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES:

- Sharing the love of Jesus with the children of Casa De Mi Padre. Spending time with the kids is always a favorite. These times can include scheduled games, programs, or simple 'hang out' time with the kids. We also have a big birthday party with any children having birthdays while we are there. We can purchase gifts here to take down in our suitcases. We will be eating some of our meals with them as well.
- Participating in a special Women's Event for the women in the local church there.
 (Serving dinner, special music, message and helping with set up, etc.)
- Serving those living in extreme poverty at the Guatemalan Dump by bringing food and other necessities to them and sharing the Gospel of Jesus. These dump communities often include entire families (parents and children) who spend their days scavenging through the dump for materials to resell.

- → \$1,100 due by <u>July 15</u>

DESTINATION: Santa Cruz del Quiche, Guatemala FLIGHT: Kansas City \rightarrow Atlanta \rightarrow Guatemala City.

→ From there we will drive to Santa Cruz. (roughly 4hrs) In Santa Cruz, we will stay at the mission guesthouse, which is about 10 minutes from the Children's Home. We will have morning breakfast and devotions together as a team at the guest house.

- → Sharing the love of Jesus with the children of Casa De Mi Padre Children's Home which includes playing games, having meals with them and just 'hanging out.'
- Evangelism opportunities in nearby villages throughout the week where we will be visiting public or private schools. This team will create an exciting children or youth program that will give the group a platform to entertain and interest the kids in order to present the gospel. The students will be encouraged to come back in the evening bringing their family and friends to watch the Jesus Film where an invitation to receive Christ will be given.

OTHER ITEMS


- → Ministry supplies
